

Colour!



During this topic the children will become artists. They will each receive their own sketchbooks, will explore colour and learn how to mix their own. The children will learn to use a variety of different art materials.

We will learn the story of Little Red Riding Hood and act it out in the role play. We will create a small world of the story and will have a go at writing it ourselves!



During the topic we will be learning about and celebrating the Holi festival of colour. We will

also invite you to visit our reception art gallery with your child to view and buy artwork

produced by the children.



In maths the children will continue to work on becoming secure with basic number skills to 20 such as counting forwards and backwards, number recognition, simple addition and subtraction and units of measure. We will also start to introduce other mathematical concepts such as money and time.

Ways to help at home:

Please continue to read with your child as often as you can. Use your letters and sounds card and practise the sounds given every week in the homework.

Practise counting every day in different contexts – in the supermarket, counting cars, sharing between toys.
