If a child chooses to attend a club we would hope that child would come each week. If your child is not attending a club please let the office know so that we do not chase up the whereabouts of him/her.

If a club has to be cancelled, we do our best to notify the children in advance. If this has not been possible, we will look after the children at school until the time the club should have finished. **Sometimes, outdoor clubs have to be cancelled on the afternoon they are due to take place because of bad weather. It would be helpful to let your child know in the morning what they should do if this has to happen; you may wish to tell them to come home in the usual way. If there is no other arrangement, we will keep the children in school until the time the club would have ended.**

Lunchtime clubs and Y3–6 clubs do not require a permission slip (with the exception of the Y3 Rock Stars club). However we do keep weekly registers which are held in the school office.

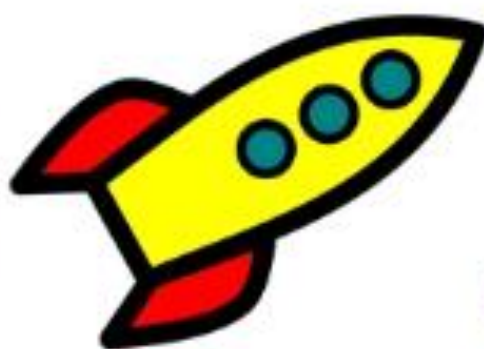
