The School Admissions Code 2014 stipulates that schools must inform parents of the outcome of any tests BEFORE parents submit their Supplementary Information Form (SIF) and their Local Authority Common Application Form (CAF) sometimes known as the Secondary Transfer Form (STF).

Therefore the following timetable will apply for the Language and Music Aptitude Tests. Please note this applies to **DAY applications only**. Siblings of day students already at Hockerill College and who will not be in Year 13 in September 2018 do not need to sit the tests.

Summer Term 2018	Test date published. Test Application Form (TAF) available online from Hockerill College Website (www.hockerill.com). A paper copy is available on request but we would appreciate applications being completed online if at all possible.
Michaelmas Term 2018 1 October 2018 (0900 hours)	Closing date for receipt of TAFs.
By 3 October 2018	Notification to parents of time/location of tests via email.
Saturday 6 October 2018	Language & Music Aptitude Tests held at Hockerill College
Week commencing 15 October 2018	Notification of results sent to parents by email.
31 October 2018	Closing date for submission of CAF to Home Local Authority and Supplementary Information Form (SIF) to Hockerill.
