Dear Parents

School Journey to Norfolk

May I remind you that any remaining balance for this trip should be paid by Friday 5 April 2019. If you are having any problems with payment please let us know and we will do what we can to help.

Once the cost of the trip has been paid, pocket money can be sent in advance up to a maximum amount of £10.00. The children will be told not to bring any money with them on the trip. This should be sent to the office in an envelope marked with your child's name and it would be extremely helpful if this could comprise 10 x £1 coins (or as much as you would like to give them up to the maximum amount). The pocket money will be handed out in instalments by the adult in charge of your child's group.

Clothing

Please don't invest in a lot of new clothing for the trip! The children will need to be dressed in comfortable clothes for outdoor activities. Jeans, trousers and shorts with t-shirts and sweatshirts are suitable clothing for the day and evening. The children will need a change of footwear for use in the hostel. For walking, they will need trainers. It is absolutely essential (based on previous experience) that the children bring a lightweight fully waterproof jacket, a warm fleece or jumper and also a sun hat and sun protection lotion in case of wet/cold/hot weather.

The children should have one case or bag for their clothes and must have a small rucksack type bag (with straps to wear on their backs) in which to carry their waterproof coat and lunch each day.

The teachers will be giving the children more information about the trip in the last weeks before they go. We shall be speaking to them about the journey, the hostel and the places they will visit.

Before we go, you will receive another letter confirming times of departure and arrival and giving emergency address and contact numbers.
